- 1) Existing system and practice in the domain
- 2) Least account for historical narratives but only relevant to the theme of the paper
- 3) Threats and Challenges
- 4) Suggestions and solution with emphasis on future role

### ***Paper Submission***

Formatting Instructions: Times New Roman, 1.5 space, MS Word 2007 (upto).

*Abstract:* Not exceeding 250 words

*Final Paper:* Not exceeding 1000 to 1500 words

*Final Presentation:* 20 minutes each in ppt format (to be sent prior to the conference)

### ***Terms and Conditions***

All submissions will be peer reviewed and evaluated based on originality, technical and/or research content/depth, correctness, relevance to the Conference, contributions, and readability. Submissions will be chosen based on merit, interest, applicability, and how well they fit a coherent and balanced program based on the selected themes.
