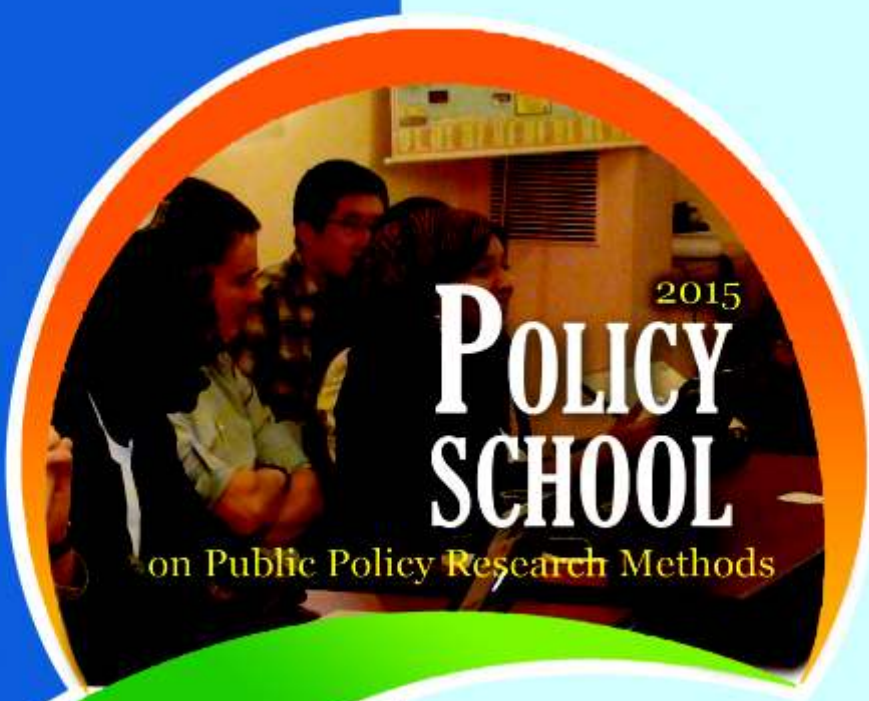

Who should apply?

- ✓ Candidates having keen interest in public policy research
 - ✓ Should have minimum three years of experience in research
 - ✓ Should have a valid undergraduate degree
 - ✓ Should be minimum 23 years of age
 - ✓ Should be proficient in English Language (spoken and written)
 - ✓ Able to arrange travel documents from their country of arrival.
- The organizers will issue each participant with a call letter and offer partial/ full travel grant, if required.

- ✓ Gain in-depth knowledge about diverse aspects of policy research
